Niké Wentholt is a lecturer at the University of Groningen, the Netherlands. As part of the Dialogics of Justice-team, she will conduct a socio-legal analysis to explore new ways of thinking about recognition and repair. She closely works together with other researchers from the project (Naomi Ormskerk, Marrit Woutwijk, Obiozo Ukpabi, Nicole Immler), who will study four distinct case studies that examine different institutional contexts for victims' claims for recognition. She has completed her PhD project at the University of Groningen. Her dissertation was titled: 'Overcoming History, Becoming European? Politics of the Past and EU Accession in Serbia and Bulgaria'.
